## JUNE UPDATE: FREE MEALS AVAILABLE TO CHILDREN WHILE SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED

Keystone Central School District is providing FREE breakfast and lunch meals to all children through the National School Lunch Program's Seamless Summer Option program. This program is open to all children in our community.



FREE meals will be distributed every Monday and Thursday.

Children will receive 7 breakfast meals and 7 lunch meals per week.

Lunch and breakfast for multiple days will be served to families and caregivers by a drive through / walk-up pick up from 11:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. at the following locations:

Central Mountain Middle School - front entrance by cafeteria
Liberty Curtin Elementary - front entrance
Renovo Elementary - front entrance
Robb Elementary - front entrance
Sugar Valley Fire Company - main parking lot
Woodward Elementary - student drop off, side door

- Breakfast and lunch are available to any child age 18 and younger.
- All breakfast and lunch meals should be refrigerated as soon as possible. Hot entrees
  and vegetables should be reheated in the microwave or on a stove. Uneaten perishable
  breakfast and lunch food received Monday should be discarded on Thursday, and
  uneaten perishable breakfast and lunch food received on Thursday should be discarded
  on the following Monday.
- Children, parents, caregivers, and family members will not be permitted into school buildings. Meals are meant to be taken home to eat.

- Families may walk to all school sites to pick up meals but are asked not to congregate at the pick up site to help prevent illness.
- Starting June 8 Free Farm to Family Food Boxes will be available at Robb Elementary and Woodward Elementary Schools every Monday and will be available every Thursday at Central Mountain Middle School and Renovo Elementary School during regular meal distribution times 11:00 AM 12:30 PM on a first come, first serve basis. In addition to children's breakfast and lunch meals, the Farm to Family Food Box may contain items such as shelf stable milk, frozen prepared dinner entrees, and/or a fresh fruit and fresh vegetable box.
